**2. Layout (Fig. 1)**

1. Bit chuck
2. Changeover switch
3. ON/OFF switch
4. Battery pack
5. Pushlock button
6. LED light
7. Battery charger

**3. Items supplied**

- Open the packaging and take out the equipment with care.
- Remove the packaging material and any packaging and/or transportation braces (if available).
- Check to see if all items are supplied.
- Inspect the equipment and accessories for transport damage.
- If possible, please keep the packaging until the end of the guarantee period.

**IMPORTANT**

**The equipment and packaging material are not toys. Do not let children play with plastic bags, foils or small parts. There is a danger of swallowing or suffocating!**

**4. Proper use**

The cordless drill/screwdriver is designed for tightening and undoing screws, as well as for drilling in wood, metal and plastic.

The machine is to be used only for its prescribed purpose. Any other use is deemed to be a case of misuse. The user / operator and not the manufacturer will be liable for any damage or injuries of any kind caused as a result of this.

Please note that our equipment has not been designed for use in commercial, trade or industrial applications. Our warranty will be voided if the machine is used in commercial, trade or industrial businesses or for equivalent purposes.

### Additional information for electric power tools

### Keep the noise emissions and vibrations to a minimum.

### Residual risks

**Even if you use this electric power tool in accordance with instructions, certain residual risks cannot be ruled out. The following hazards may arise in connection with the equipment's construction and layout:**

1. Lung damage if no suitable protective dust mask is used.
2. Damage to hearing if no suitable ear protection is used.
3. Health damage caused by hand-arm vibrations if the equipment is used over a prolonged period or is not properly guided and maintained.

## 6. Before starting the equipment

Be sure to read the following information before you use your cordless screwdriver for the first time:

1. Charge the battery pack with the charger supplied. An empty battery pack requires a charging period of approximately one hour.
2. Only ever use sharp drill bits and screwdriver bits which are suitable for the purpose and in faultless condition.
3. Always check for concealed electric cables and gas and water pipes when drilling and screwing in walls.

## 7. Operation

### 7.1 Charging the Li battery pack (Fig. 2-3)

The battery is protected from exhaustive discharge.

An integrated protective circuit automatically switches off the equipment when the battery is flat. In this case the bit chuck will cease to turn.

**Warning!** Do not press the ON/OFF switch any more if the protective circuit has actuated. This may damage the battery.

1. Remove the battery pack (4) from the handle, pressing the pushlock buttons (5) on the left and right sides to do so.
2. Check that your mains voltage is the same as that marked on the rating plate of the battery charger. Insert the power plug of the charger (7) into the mains socket outlet. The green LED will then begin to flash.
3. Insert the battery pack (4) into the battery charger (7).
4. In section 11 "Charger indicator" you will find a table with an explanation of the LED indicator on the charger.

If the battery pack fails to become charged, please check

- whether there is voltage at the socket-outlet
- whether there is proper contact with the charging contacts in the battery charger (7).

If the battery still fails to become charged, please return

- the charger and charging adapter
  - the battery pack
- to our Customer Service Department.

To ensure that the Li battery pack provides long service you should take care to recharge it promptly. You must recharge the battery pack when you notice that the power of the cordless screwdriver drops.

#### 7.2 Forward/Reverse switch (Fig. 4 / Item 2)

With the slide switch above the On/Off switch you can select the direction of rotation of the battery-powered drill/screwdriver and secure it against being switched on accidentally. You can choose between clockwise and anticlockwise rotation. To avoid causing damage to the gearing it is advisable to change the direction of rotation only when the tool is at a standstill. The On/Off switch is blocked when the slide switch is in centre position.

#### 7.3 On/Off switch (Fig. 4 / Item 3)

Infinitely variable speed control is possible with the On/Off switch. The further you press the switch, the higher the speed of the battery-powered drill/screwdriver.

#### 7.4 LED lamp (Fig. 4/Item 6)

The LED lamp (6) can be used in poor lighting conditions to illuminate the area where you want to drill or screw. The LED lamp (6) will be lit automatically as soon as you press the ON/OFF switch (3).

#### 7.5 Changing the tool (Fig. 5)

**Important.** Set the changeover switch (2) to its centre position whenever you carry out any work (for example changing the tool, maintenance work, etc.) on the cordless screwdriver.

- Pull the sleeve on the chuck (1) towards the screw. Insert the screw bit all the way into the chuck
- Then pull the screw bit slightly till it automatically locks into place.

#### 7.6 Tightening screws

- Plug the required bit in the chuck like mentioned in point 7.5
- Select the correct direction of rotation on the hammer screwdriver
- Push the drive socket insert onto the screw head and actuate the ON/OFF switch.
- For as long as the screw is untightened, the tool works as a normal screwdriver. Only when the screw is tightened does the tool work as a hammer screwdriver.
- It is imperative that you use a torque wrench to check a torque which has been specified by a manufacturer. In doing so, ensure that you observe the information supplied by the manufacturer in the directions for use.
- Most mounting parts can be tightened within a few seconds. The time required to achieve the maximum torque depends on the actual case of application and can be determined with experience.

#### 7.7 Loosening screws

For as long as the screw is tightened, the tool works as a hammer screwdriver. As soon as the screw is untightened, the tool operates as a normal screwdriver.

### 8. Cleaning, maintenance and ordering of spare parts

Always pull out the mains power plug before starting any cleaning work.

#### 8.1 Cleaning

- Keep all safety devices, air vents and the motor housing free of dirt and dust as far as possible. Wipe the equipment with a clean cloth or blow it with compressed air at low pressure.
- We recommend that you clean the device immediately each time you have finished using it.
- Clean the equipment regularly with a moist cloth and some soft soap. Do not use cleaning agents or solvents; these could attack the plastic parts of the equipment. Ensure that no water can seep into the device.

#### 8.2 Maintenance

There are no parts inside the equipment which require additional maintenance.



### 8.3 Ordering replacement parts

Please quote the following data when ordering replacement parts:

- Type of machine
- Article number of the machine
- Identification number of the machine
- Replacement part number of the part required

## 9. Disposal and recycling

The unit is supplied in packaging to prevent its being damaged in transit. This packaging is raw material and can therefore be reused or can be returned to the raw material system.

The unit and its accessories are made of various types of material, such as metal and plastic.

Defective components must be disposed of as special waste. Ask your dealer or your local council.

## 10. Storage

Store the equipment and accessories out of children's reach in a dark and dry place at above freezing temperature. The ideal storage temperature is between 5 and 30 °C. Store the electric tool in its original packaging.




## 11. Charger indicator

Indicator status		Explanations and actions
Red LED	Green LED	
Off	Flashing	<b>Ready for use</b> The charger is connected to the mains and is ready for use; there is no battery pack in the charger
On	Off	<b>Charging</b> The charger is charging the battery pack in quick charge mode.
Off	On	The battery pack is fully charged (charging completed) <b>Action:</b> Take the battery pack out of the charger. Disconnect the charger from the mains supply.
Flashing	Off	<b>Adapted charging</b> The charger is in gentle charging mode. For safety reasons the charging is performed less quickly and takes more than 1 hour. The reasons can be: - The battery pack has not been used for a very long time or an already flat battery was further discharged (exhaustive discharge) - The battery pack temperature is outside the ideal range (between 10° C and 45° C). <b>Action:</b> Wait for the charging to be completed; you can still continue to charge the battery pack.
Flashing	Flashing	<b>Fault</b> Charging is no longer possible. The battery pack is defective. <b>Action:</b> Never charge a defective battery pack. Take the battery pack out of the charger.
On	On	<b>Temperature fault</b> The battery pack is too hot (e.g. due to direct sunshine) or too cold (below 0° C). <b>Action:</b> Remove the battery pack and keep it at room temperature (approx. 20° C) for one day.

- 1 The benefits conferred by the Einhell Express Guarantee are in addition to all rights and remedies which you may be entitled to under the Australian Consumer Law, and any other statutory rights you may have under other applicable laws. This Einhell Express Guarantee does not exclude, restrict or modify any such rights or remedies.  
We do not charge you for the Einhell Express Guarantee.
- 2 Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.
