

## **PETROL CHAINSAW**

## **QUICK START GUIDE**

## Easy steps to getting started.

- 1. Ensure all items, including your manual are removed from the packaging before discarding.
- 2. Check the tension of the chain and adjust if necessary (refer to section 5.3 in the instruction manual).
- 3. Fuel the chainsaw using unleaded fuel and 2 Stroke oil to a ratio of 35:1. Fill the fuel tank (A) with correct fuel mixture (Fig. 11).
- 4. Fill the oil tank (B) with chain oil (Fig. 11).
- 5. Be certain the chain brake is disengaged (C) before starting unit (Fig. 11).
- 6. Once you have filled the chain and oil tank, tighten the tank cover securely by hand. Do not use any tools to
- 7. Set the On/Off switch (A) to "On (I)" to start the machine (Fig. 12A).
- 8. Pull out the choke (B) (Fig. 12B) until it locks.
- 9. Push the primer bulb (C) 10 times (Fig. 12C).
- 10. Place saw on a firm, flat surface. Hold saw firmly as shown. Pull starter rapidly 2 times. Beware of moving chain!
- 11. Push in the choke (B) as far as it will go (Fig. 12B).
- 12. Hold saw firmly and pull starter rapidly 4 times. Engine should start (Fig. 12).
- 13. Let the engine run for 10 seconds to warm up. Press the throttle trigger (D) briefly, the engine will go to "idling" speed (Fig. 12E).
- 14. To stop engine release trigger and allow engine to return to idle speed.
- 15. Move STOP switch down to stop engine.
- 16. Check to ensure that the working environment is safe as prescribed in the instrution manual.
