Explanation of the plate (see Fig. 13)

- 1. Warning
- Keep out of the rain and protect from getting 2.
- 3. Read the operating instructions before using for the first time.
- Pull the plug from the power supply immediately if the cable gets damaged or severed.
- 5. Wear eye, hearing and head protection.
- 6 Wear safety boots.
- 7. Wear safety gloves.
- 8. Pull the power plug before carrying out maintenance, cleaning and repair work.
- 9. Keep all other persons away from the danger
- Maintain a safety distance of at least 10 m from overhead lines

- Fastening screws for hand guard

Important! You must never use the hedge trimmer without hand guard.

Proper use


Important! This hedge trimmer is designed for the trimming of hedges, bushes and shrubs.

Adjustable handle on the equipment

While pressing the 2 locks (Figure 6b/Item 11) at the same time, the handle can be turned into 5 different positions.

Then release the locks and make sure they lock back into place correctly. The equipment can now be used to cut the tops of hedges as for example shown in Figure 6c.

Operation

Connect the equipment's power supply cable to the plug (Figure 4/Item B) and secure the power cable with the strain-relief clamp (Figure 4/Item 5).

Important. To prevent accidental start-up of the equipment, the cordless hedge trimmer is equipped with a safety switch (Figure 4/Item 10) which must be pressed before the ON/OFF switch (Figure 4/Item 9) can be pressed.

If the ON/OFF switch is released, the equipment switches off. The equipment is fitted with a safety switch and an ON/OFF switch on both sides of the handle, enabling you to select the suitable position depending on the work situation. The extension bar is also fitted with a safety switch and an ON/ OFF switch with the same functions. Repeat this process several times so that you are sure that your equipment functions properly.

Before starting the equipment

Before you connect the equipment to the mains supply make sure that the data on the rating plate are identical to the mains data.

Fitting the hand guard

Slide on the hand guard (Figure 3a/Item 2) in the direction indicated by the arrow (Figure 3a) Then secure with 2 screws (Figure 3b/Item 13) (Figure 3b).

Fitting the extension bar

Undo the union nut (Figure 4/Item A) and remove from the equipment complete with the power cable (Figure 5a/Item 6). When fitting the extension bar, make sure the plug-in contact (Figure 5b/Item C) is installed in the correct direction. Then secure the extension cable with the union nut (Figure 5c/Item D).

Adjustable handle on the extension bar

Push the handle (Figure 6a/Item E) in the direction indicated by the arrow and hold. You can now turn the handle (Figure 6a/Item E) in steps of 90°. Release the handle and make sure it locks into place correctly. The extension bar is equipped with an adjustable carrying strap (Figure 1/Item 12) for userfriendly handling.

In so doing, please check the running of the blades.

- Please check that the blades function correctly. The blades cut on both sides and run in opposite directions to each other, for guaranteed high cutting performance and quiet operation.
- Fasten the extension cable to the cable holder before starting to use the machine (see Fig. 4).
- For use in the open air you must only use extension cables certified for the purpose.

Tips on use

- The hedge trimmer can be used not only for trimming hedges but for trimming shrubs and bushes as well.
- For optimum trimming performance, guide the blade teeth at an angle of approx. 15° to the hedge (see Fig. 7).
- Since the blades cut on both sides and run in opposite directions to each other, you can trim in both directions (see Fig. 8).
- . To achieve a hedge with a uniform height it is recommended that you stretch a piece of string along the edge of the hedge for guidance. Then simply cut away all twigs projecting above the line (see Fig. 9).
- The sides of the hedge should be trimmed with arc-type movements from below upwards (see Fig. 10).

Replacing the power cable

If the power cable for this equipment is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its aftersales service or similarly trained personnel to avoid danger.

Cleaning, maintenance and ordering of spare parts

Always pull out the mains power plug before starting any cleaning work.

8.1 Cleaning

- . Keep all safety devices, air vents and the motor housing free of dirt and dust as far as possible. Wipe the equipment with a clean cloth or blow it with compressed air at low pressure.
- We recommend that you clean the device immediately each time you have finished using it.
- Clean the equipment regularly with a moist cloth and some soft soap. Do not use cleaning agents or solvents; these could attack the plastic partsof the equipment. Ensure that no water can seepinto the device

8.2 Carbon brushes

In case of excessive sparking, have the carbon brushes checked only by a qualified electrician. Important! The carbon brushes should not be rep laced by anyone but a qualified electrician.

Disposal and recycling

The unit is supplied in packaging to prevent its being damaged in transit. This packaging is raw material and can therefore be reused or can be returned to the raw material system.

The unit and its accessories are made of various types of material, such as metal and plastic. Defective components must be disposed of as special waste. Ask your dealer or your local council.

Faults

The machine does not start:

Check that the power cable is correctly connected and check the mains fuses. If the machine still does not work even with connected voltage, please send it to the specified customer services address.





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
