



You will need 8mm, 13mm and 14mm open-ended spanners and a #2 Phillips screwdriver for the assembly (not supplied).




Fitting the Lower Handles

1. Fit the lower handle onto the roller.




2. Fit the thread of the dirt wiper into the lower handle and secure in place, first with M8 locking nut and then M8 dome nut.






Fitting the Upper Handles

1. Place the upper handle over the upper ends of the lower handle.




2. Fit the M5 screws through the upper handle and then through the holes in the lower handle. Secure in place with a washer and M5 locking nut.



Once assembled, fill the roller with water or dry sand via the fill port.




Adjusting the Dirt Wiper

Rotate the dirt wiper so the front part of the wiper wipes away so that as little soil as possible remains on the roller.



Changing the Weight

Changing the weight is easy, and requires no tools. Simply fill or empty the roller of water or dry sand until the roller is at the desired weight.





Overlapping Rows

When rolling a lawn, slightly overlap the row that has already been rolled. Overlapping rows will also ensure a neat roll by flattening grass or dirt that may have been missed on the previous row.
