
Reading and storing the user manual

Safety

Intended use

The scarifier is designed solely for scarifying purposes. This scarifier is intended only for private use and is not suitable for the commercial sector. Use the scarifier only in the way described in these operating instructions. Any other use is deemed to be a case of mis-use and may result in material damage or even personal injury. The scarifier is not a toy.

The manufacturer or dealer accepts no liability for damages and injuries of any kind which result from improper or incorrect use.

Residual hazards

Even when the scarifier is used as intended, it is impossible to completely rule out non-obvious residual risks.

The following hazards may arise due to the nature of the scarifier:

- Damage to hearing if no suitable ear protection is used.
- Health damage caused by hand-arm vibrations if the equipment is used over a longer period or is not properly guided and maintained.

Safety information



Read all the safety information and instructions. Failure to adhere to the safety information and instructions set out below may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.



Risk of short-circuiting!

If liquids get inside the scarifier they could cause short-circuiting.

If you then come into contact with the scarifier you might suffer an electric shock. A short-circuit could also damage the scarifier.

 If it begins to rain while scarifying is in progress, switch off the scarifier immediately and pull out the plug.



Risk of an electric shock!

A faulty electrical installation or too high a mains voltage could cause an electric shock.

- Before you connect the scarifier to the power supply make sure that the supply voltage at the power socket complies with the specifications on the rating plate.
- Use an extension cable of type H05RN-F or H05VVF, or ideally with a cable cross-section of at least 2 x 1.5 mm². The extension cable is not allowed to be longer than 20 m.
- Do not use the scarifier if it has visible signs of damage or if the power connection is defective.
- Do not use the scarifier with a defective extension cable.
- Do not change the motor settings. Do not overload the motor.
- Do not immerse the scarifier, the extension cable or the power plug in water or other liquids.
- Never grip the power plug with damp hands.
- Never pull the power plug out of the socket by pulling on the extension cable - always grip the power plug.
- Never use the power cable as a carry-handle. Always carry the scarifier by its carry-handle.
- Keep the scarifier power cable and the extension cable away from naked flames, hot surfaces, oil and sharp edges.
- Position the extension cable so that it does not become a tripping hazard.

- Do not kink the power cable or the extension cable and do not pull them over sharp edges.
- Do not drive the scarifier over the extension cable.
- Make sure that there are no knots in the extension cable.
- Make sure that no objects protrude into the scarifier housing.
- Switch off the scarifier and disconnect it from the power supply when you no longer want to use it, when you would like to clean or service it, or when a malfunction arises.



Beware of sharp blades!

The scarifier uses a fast-rotating roller with sharp blades. If you handle it without due care you could injure yourself or others with it. Small objects (stones, sticks, wire, bones and the like) can be catapulted by the rotating roller into the surroundings. As the result you could injure yourself or other persons severely.

- As the operator of the equipment you are responsible for accidents or risks involving other persons or their property.
- Make sure that all nuts, bolts and screws are tightened securely and that the scarifier is in a safe condition.
- Never lift or carry the scarifier with the motor running.
- The roller rotates for a short time after the scarifier is switched off.
 Wait for the roller to stop rotating before you lift, carry, tilt or transport the scarifier.
- Switch off the scarifier and pull out the extension cable from the power socket before you lift, carry or roll it in a tilted position to another location.
- Never move your hands or feet toward or under any rotating parts. Keep clear of the ejector opening at all times.
- Make sure that your feet are far enough away from the roller.

- Do not start the motor if you are standing in front of the ejector chute.
- Never use the scarifier with damaged or missing safety devices,
 e.g. without a deflector plate and/or catch bag.
- Switch off the scarifier and pull out the extension cable from the power socket if the scarifier begins to react with exceptionally strong vibrations. Wait until the roller stops moving. Check the scarifier for damage. If you find no signs of damage, have the scarifier checked by trained personnel.
- Remove all tools, adjusting devices and similar from the scarifier before you switch on the scarifier.
- Avoid starting the scarifier unintentionally. Make sure that the Start button is in the OFF position before you pull out the extension cable from the power socket.
- Never use or service the scarifier if you are tired or under the influence of medication, alcohol or other substances that cloud your senses.



Risk of explosion!

Sparks could form if the scarifier roller or catapulted objects strike metal. These sparks could ignite combustible liquids, gases or dust.

 Do not use the scarifier in areas where there is a risk of explosion or where there are inflammable liquids, gases or dust.

WARNING!

Hazards for children and persons with limited physical, sensory or mental capacities (e.g. partly handicapped persons, elderly persons with limited physical and mental capacities) or those lacking experience and knowledge (e.g. older children).

- This scarifier is not designed to be used by people (including children) with limited physical, sensory or mental capacities or those with no experience and/or knowledge unless they are supervised by a person who is responsible for their safety or they have received instructions from such a person in to how to use the equipment safely. Children must always be supervised in order to ensure that they do not play with the equipment.
- Keep children younger than eight years of age away from the scarifier and the power cable.
- Do not leave the scarifier unattended while it is in use.
- Do not allow children to play with the plastic packaging. They could become caught up in it and suffocate.

NOTICE!

Risk of damage!

Improper handling of the scarifier could cause damage to it.

- Do not let the power cable touch hot parts.
- Never expose the scarifier to high temperatures (heaters etc.) or to the weather (rain etc.).
- Never pour liquid into the scarifier.
- Never clean the scarifier by immersing it in water or using a steam cleaner. The scarifier could be damaged as the result.
- Stop using the scarifier if its plastic components develop cracks or fractures or if they become deformed. Replace damaged components only with matching original spare parts.

- Switch off the scarifier if you cross any surfaces other than grass and while transporting the scarifier from and to the area you wish to use it on.
- Check the catch basket regularly for wear or damaged parts.

Explanation of the warning signs on the equipment (see Fig. 15)

- A = Important! Read the operating instructions before using for the first time.
- B = Keep other persons (and animals) away from the danger zone.
- C = Caution, sharp blades. The blades continue to rotate after the equipment is switched off pull the plug out of the power socket before carrying out any maintenance or if the cable becomes damaged.
- D = Wear hearing and eye protection.
- E = Keep the power cable away from the blades.

Keep this safety information in a safe place!

Using for the first time

Checking the scarifier and items supplied

NOTICE!

Risk of damage!

If you open the packaging without care using a sharp knife or other pointed objects, this could quickly cause damage to the scarifier.

- Open the packaging and take out the equipment with care.
- Remove the packaging material and any packaging and/or transportation braces (if present).
- Check to see if all the items are supplied.
- Inspect the equipment and accessories for transport damage.
- If possible, keep the packaging until the end of the guarantee period.
- Check that the equipment after unpacking to ensure that it is complete and check it for damage which may have occurred in transit – to prevent hazards. If you have any doubts, do not use it but contact our customer service instead. You will find the service address in our warranty terms on the warranty card.



Risk of injury!

The equipment and packaging material are not toys. Do not let children play with plastic bags, plastic sheets and small parts. There is a risk of choking and suffocating!

Assembling the scarifier

Fitting the push bar holders (Fig. 3 and 4)

- 1. Undo the push bar fastener () by turning.
- 2. Push the left push bar holder () into position and fasten it again with the push bar fastener ().
- 3. Proceed in the same order with the right push bar holder (111).
- 4. Make sure that the teeth of the two components intermesh.

Fitting the lower push bar (Fig. 5)

- 1. Before fitting, make sure that the cable strain-relief clip (4) is pushed over the tube.
- Now fasten the lower push bar (4) to the push bar holders (5 and 1) with the help of the quick release locks (13) as shown in Fig. 5.

Fitting the upper push bar (Fig. 6)

- 1. Now fasten the upper push bar () to the lower push bar () with the help of the quick release locks () as shown in **Fig. 6**.
- 2. You can use the two cable clips () to fasten the cable to the push bar.

Fitting the catch basket (Fig. 7)

To fit the catch basket () to the scarifier you must lift the ejector flap () with one hand while you hook the catch basket onto the scarifier with the other.

Operation



Risk of injury!

The scarifier uses a fast-rotating roller with sharp blades. If you handle it without due care you could injure yourself or others with it. Small objects (stones, sticks, wire, bones and the like) can be catapulted into the surroundings. As the result you could injure yourself or other persons severely. Furthermore there is electricity running through the scarifier. Incorrect handling could result in a short-circuit, an explosion or an electric shock.

- Do not use the scarifier in the rain or during a thunder storm.
- Check the ground where you would like to use the scarifier. Remove stones, sticks, wire, bones and other foreign bodies that could be caught up and catapulted into the surroundings.
- Never use the scarifier while other persons, particularly children, or animals are nearby.
- Each time before use, always visually examine the tools and bolts for signs of wear or damage. Worn or damaged tools must always be replaced as complete units in order to avoid imbalance.
- Use the scarifier only in broad daylight or with good artificial lighting.
- To prevent injury, wear protective gloves when changing the roller.
- Move the scarifier at walking pace only.
- Hold the handlebars firmly with both hands when driving the scarifier.
- Avoid using the scarifier on damp grass or take special care to ensure that you do not slip.
- Always maintain good footing, especially on slopes.

- Always work across slopes, never straight up or down.
- Be particularly careful when you change direction on a slope.
- Do not work on overly steep slopes. Switch off the scarifier and pull out the power plug. Wait for the roller to come to a standstill before you clear away any blockages or remove jammed items from the ejector opening.
- Switch off the scarifier and pull out the power plug when you interrupt your work.
- Switch off the scarifier and wait until the roller has come to a standstill before you remove or fit the catch basket.
- Always wear sturdy footwear and long trousers when working with the scarifier.

NOTICE!

In the course of time, lawns develop a matted layer of stems, shoots or moss. To loosen up this layer you should scarify the lawn twice a year. The lawn should be mowed before you start. Spring and late summer are good times for scarifying.

The ground is then no longer frozen and afterwards it will have enough time to regenerate for winter. In the case of severely matted areas of grass you should scarify lengthways as well as crossways. Take care that the sward does not dry out.

Adjusting the scarifying depth (Fig. 8)

NOTICE!

Risk of material damage!

- If the scarifying depth is set wrongly, this could damage the roller or the surface underneath.
- Each time before you use the scarifier, check the depth setting in order to avoid damaging the surface underneath.

You can set the following scarifying depths:

- 0 = drive/transport position
- 1 = scarifying depth 0 mm
- 2 = scarifying depth 3 mm
- 3 = scarifying depth 8 mm
- 4 = scarifying depth 12 mm

To set the scarifying depth, proceed in the following order:

- 1. Press the height adjustment handle () toward the motor.
- 2. Pull or push the height adjustment handle () to the level required.
- 3. Check finally that the handle engages correctly in the required position.

Replacing the roller (Fig. 9 - 12)



Beware of sharp blades!

The scarifier uses a fast-rotating roller with sharp blades. If you handle it without due care you could injure yourself or others with it. Small objects (stones, sticks, wire, bones and the like) can be catapulted by the rotating roller into the surroundings. As the result you could injure yourself or other persons severely.

- Before you use the scarifier, check that you have assembled it correctly.
- To prevent injury, wear protective gloves when you fit the roller.

This product comes complete with 2 rollers:

- The scarifier roller (pre-fitted) is suitable for lawn maintenance and aeration.
- The aerator roller () comes separate and is suitable for gathering leaves, moss and weeds from the lawn.

To change rollers, proceed in the following order (Fig. 9 and 13)

- 1. Pull out the power plug and be sure to wear protective gloves!
- 2. Turn the scarifier upside down.
- 3. Release the holder (A) by pulling the release button (B).
- 4. Swing up the holder (A) so that the scarifier roller or aerator roller is exposed.
- 5. Press the scarifier roller or aerator roller out of the holder as shown in **Fig. 11**.
- 6. You can now remove the scarifier roller or aerator roller from the scarifier.

- 7. To insert the required scarifier roller or aerator roller, proceed in reverse order.
- 8. Make sure that the drive hex engages correctly when fitting (**Fig. 13**).

Switching the scarifier on and off

- 1. Connect the scarifier to the power supply (**Fig. 14**), passing the cable through the cable strain-relief clip (14).
- 2. Now press and hold the safety lock-off () before pulling the On/Off control bar () against the upper push bar ().
- 3. You can then release the safety lock-off.
- 4. To switch off, simply let go of the On/ Off control bar () and the scarifier will stop.

Cleaning and maintenance



WARNING!

Risk of injury!

There is a risk of serious injuries if the scarifier is handled incorrectly.

- Switch off the scarifier and pull the power plug out of the power socket before you start any cleaning work.
- Wear suitable protective gloves when you work with the scarifier.

NOTICE!

Risk of short-circuiting!

Water or other liquids inside the housing could cause a short-circuit.

- The power plug must always be pulled out of the socket outlet before starting any cleaning or maintenance work.
- Never immerse the scarifier in water or other liquids.
- Do not use a high-pressure cleaner to clean the scarifier.
- Make sure that no water or other liquids get into the housing.

NOTICE!

Risk of damage!

Incorrect or irregular cleaning and maintenance could result in damage to the scarifier.

- Keep all safety devices, air vents and the motor housing free of dirt and dust as far as possible.
- Clean the scarifier each time after using it.
- To avoid damaging its surfaces do not use aggressive cleaning products, brushes with metal or nylon bristles, and sharp or metallic cleaning implements such as knives, hard spatulas or similar.

Cleaning the scarifier

- 1. Disconnect the scarifier from the power cable before you begin with the cleaning.
- 2. Clean the scarifier with a damp cloth until it is free of sap, water and dirt.
- 3. Then wait for all parts to become fully dry.

Maintenance



Risk of injury!

If the scarifier is handled incorrectly there will be a risk of serious injuries.

- Switch off the scarifier and pull its power plug out of the power socket before you start any cleaning work.
- Wear suitable protective gloves when you work with the scarifier.
- Inside the scarifier are no parts that can be repaired by the user.
 Never try to repair the scarifier yourself. Always contact a qualified expert.

NOTICE!

Risk of damage

If water gets into the housing it could cause short-circuiting.

- Never immerse the scarifier in water.
- Ensure that no water gets into the housing.

Correct and regular care is important not only for the scarifier's safe use but also for helping to extend its working life.

Replacing the power cable



Risk of electric shock!

If the power cable is damaged or not fitted properly, there will be a risk of an electric shock.

If the scarifier power cable becomes damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, by one of its customer service centers or by a similarly trained person in order to prevent hazards.

Inspecting the scarifier

Inspect the scarifier regularly to check its condition. Check whether e.g.:

- The rollers are damaged.
- The catch basket is damaged.

If you find any damage, you must arrange for it to be rectified by a service center in order to prevent hazards.

Storage

NOTICE!

Risk of damage!

The scarifier could be damaged by faulty or improper storage.

Wrong storage can cause damage to the scarifier.

It is also possible for children to be injured.

- Take care to store the scarifier in a place that cannot be accessed by children, unauthorized persons and animals.
- Disconnect the scarifier from the power supply when you are not going to use it for some time or want to store it away.
- Clean the scarifier as described in the chapter "Cleaning" and set it to the top height adjustment position before you push it to the storage area.



Store the scarifier only in a dry location which is not accessible to unauthorized persons.

Store the equipment and accessories out of children's reach in a dark and dry place at above freezing temperature. The ideal storage temperature is between 5 and 30 °C. Store the equipment in its original packaging.

Wall mounting

The wall bracket (16) can be used to mount the scarifier on the wall for storage.

- 1. Choose a place suitable for wall-mounting. It should be dry and well ventilated.
- 2. Use the supplied wall bracket screws (17) to mount the wall bracket (16) on a sturdy wall.
- 3. Fold the scarifier and hang it from the wall bracket (16).


